

"Introducing the Schweiger-Larkey Organizational Culture Index (SLOCI)"

Schweiger, Professor of Management at the University of South Carolina and Managing Director of Schweiger, Lippert and Associates and Dr. Frank Larkey, a research psychologist and former vice president of research and development for Birkman International, have decided to make the The Schweiger-Larkey Organizational Culture Index (SLOCI) available to both consultants and organizational practitioners.



The SLOCI is a valid, reliable and easy to administer web-based survey instrument that assesses 15 behavioral dimensions of organizational culture. It is used to help executives and managers align culture with business strategies; garner collaboration and cooperation among work units such as departments, divisions, geographically dispersed operations; and to facilitate joint ventures and mergers and acquisitions.

Administration of the SLOCI is simple:

- A minimum number of people in a work unit are chosen to participate (There is no maximum)
- They are provided with a User ID and Password and go to a secure web site to take the survey.
- The survey is kept open for a specified period of time and usually takes 30-45 minutes to complete.
- Upon completion of surveys, Certified SLOCI Consultants (CSC's) have access to all data and full capability to generate several different reports that:
 - Measures the nature and strength of each of the 15 dimensions of culture within any work unit
 - Assesses similarities and differences in the 15 dimensions of cultures among any number of work- units.
 - Identifies gaps between current work-unit cultures and desired cultures

The Schweiger-Larkey Group requires that anyone who wishes to administer The SLOCI become a Certified SLOCI Consultant (CSC). The certification process will help participants develop a deep understanding of organizational culture, learn how to administer the SLOCI and understand how to utilize the SLOCI to create maximum value within an organization.

Those eligible for the CSC certification process include:

- Management consultants
- HR consultants
- Internal OD or HR specialists
- Executives and Managers
